DEFINITION

Average tariffs are the simple average of all applied and valorem tariffs (tariffs based on the value of the import) applicable to the bilateral imports of developed countries. Agricultural imports comprise plant and animal produce, including tree crops, but excluding timber and fish products. Clothing and textiles include natural and synthetic fibers and fabrics and articles of clothing made from them.
