

# Gender equality of unpaid house work and care work activities in Sri Lanka

**59.7%**

59.7% of 10 years and above males participate house work and care work activities



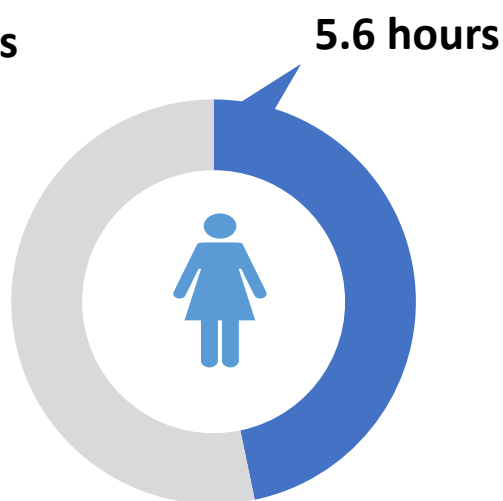
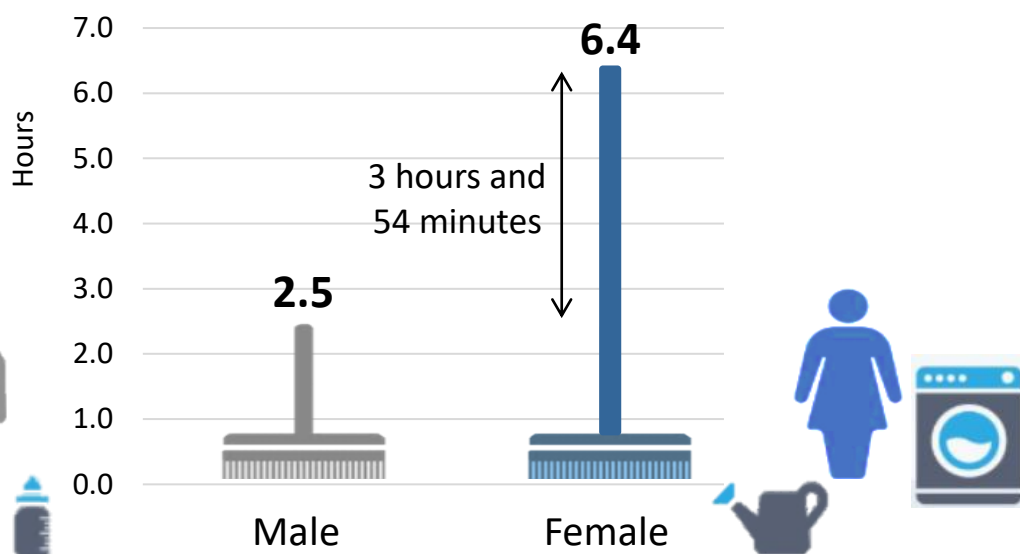
**87.3%**

87.3% of 10 years and above females participate house work and care work activities



87.3% of females were engaged 6 hours and 24 minutes per day in unpaid house work and care work activities.

59.7% of males were engaged only 2 hours and 30 minutes per day for those activities.



In reference to the total female and male population, females were spent 5 hours and 36 minutes per day in house work and care work activities while males spent 1 hour and 30 minutes.

As a percentage of 24 hour day it was 23.4% for females and 6.2% for males.

Note : These data are for Sri Lankans 10 years and above age.

Activity categories were based on International Classification of Time Use activities 2016 (ICATUS 2016).
