Grama Niladhari Divisions Statistics - 2020

Anuradhapura District

Highlights

Anuradhapura district consists with 22 Divisional Secretariat Divisions and 694 Grama Niladhari Divisions.
311,065 families are registered in election roll while highest percentage (7.4%) is reported from Nuwaragam Palatha East Divisional Secretariat Division and lowest (1.9%) is reported from Palugaswewa Divisional Secretariat Division.
Eleven Divisional Secretariat Divisions contain at least one railway Station and the Boat/ferry jetty providing transport facility is not available within any Divisional Secretariat Division.
Each and every Divisional Secretariat Division has the facility of one or more Government or private hospital. Further, 58% of the Grama Niladhari Divisions (facility is not available within the Grama Niladhari Divisions) report 5 km or more distance to access the facility of Government or private hospital.
Twenty percent of the Grama Niladhari Divisions report that the facility of Government or private school which offers classes for A/L is available within the GN. The facility of Government or private school which offers classes for O/L or below grades is available within 60% of the Grama Niladhari Divisions. Fourteen Divisional Secretariat Divisions have at least one or more schools or institutes for children with special needs.
Solid Waste Disposal System provided by local government is available in 102 (14.7%) Grama Niladhari Divisions.
Pipe borne water from national water supply or community base organization is available in 484 (69.7%) Grama Niladhari Divisions.
Wood (37%), Textile and textile handicrafts industries (13%) and Clay industry (6%) are the most common Traditional Handicraft Industries found in the district.
Majority of GN Divisions report drought (80%), damages caused by wild elephants (65%), damages caused by wild animals (47%) and storms/hurricanes (39%) under disasters happened during last 10 years.
While majority of the Grama Niladhari Divisions (637,91.8%) are involved in crop production, 45% involved in livestock, 31% involved in non-agricultural economic activities and 11% involved in fishery industries.
71,002 "Samurdhi" receivers and 27,367 Public assistance (Pin Padi) receivers are reported at the time of data collection.

Preface

A complete set of statistics on Grama Niladhari Divisions (GNDs) are published once in ten years with the Census of Population and Housing (CPH) conducted by the Department of Census and Statistics (DCS). However, GNDs have undergone a massive social as well as economic changes during the previous ten-year inter-census period, and, therefore, relevant and timely data to capture these changes is vital as a basis for development planning and also for the planning and implementation of the CPH. Therefore, having understood the importance of data for regional level development activities and for CPH 2021, the DCS conducted a collection of basic information on Grama Niladhari Divisions (GNI).

The data gathered in this activity includes information on the availability of basic facilities of the Grama Niladhari Division and the information on infrastructure, consumption of land, Government subsidies, and disaster situations. Data collection was carried out during fourth quarter 2020 and the first quarter of 2020, covering the entire country. Despite the prevailed situation of spreading COVID-19 pandemic throughout the country which occurred during the data collection period, the activity was completed successfully.

This report presents results related to the basic information on Grama Niladhari Divisions in Anuradhapura district at Divisional Secretariat level. Detailed information on Grama Niladhari Divisions will be published on Department's website. I believe this report as well as the full dataset will be highly beneficial for evidence-based decision making at any administrative level of the country.

1. Introduction

The GNI-2020 is a census type of data collection conducted during last half of the year 2020 in all around the country in parallel to Census of Population and Housing 2021. This special enumeration collected various information on Grama Niladhari Division which is the smallest administrative area in Sri Lanka. It covered all 25 districts in Sri Lanka and interviewed or asked to self-report by the officer named "Grama Niladhari (GN)" who is responsible for the particular GN Division. The main objective of this was to build a supportive database which provides basic information by the smallest administrative area for data users. Further, the data was collected on important aspects covering socio and economic related areas. This report presents the summarized statistics on Divisional Secretariat (DS) Division using the data collected at GN Division level for the Anuradhapura district. Anuradhapura district GNI-2020 data were collected during the fourth quarter 2020. The main themes covered at the data collection were,

- Background information about the immediate responsible officer for the administrative area "Grama Niladhari (GN)"
- Information on the distance to the nearest location where basic facilities are available
- Information on threats (drugs and alcohol) spread over the GN Divisions, availability of handicraft industries and disasters faced during last 10 years
- Information on economic activities (major economic activities involved, major irrigation schemes used and abandened government reservations which can be cultivated)
- Information on availability of facilitating centres for agricultural, livestock and fisheries activities
- Information on the availability of places which provide basic facilities to people
- Information on government beneficiaries for selected types of benefits .

1.1 Background information of the Grama Niladhari and Grama Niladhari Divisions

The Anuradhapura District is divided into 22 Divisional Secretariat Divisions (DSDs) and further, sub-divided into 694 Grama Niladhari Divisions (GNDs). Kekirawa DS Division has the highest number of Grama Niladhari Divisions which is 53. Padaviya is the smallest Divisional Secretariat Division in terms of Grama Niladhari Divisions.




Figure 1.1 Distribution of Grama Niladhari (permanent) by Divisional Secretariat (DS) Division and by sex

As depicted in Figure 1.1 both male and female Grama Niladharis work in every DSD and of the district as a whole majority are Male officers.

Due to various administrative reasons some GN Divisions may be vacant without a permanent officer. Therefore, a GN who is permanently attached to another division is assigned as an acting officer for a temporary period till the vacancy is filled. Table 1.2 gives the number of GN Divisions by permanent or acting status of the GN in Anuradhapura district during the survey period and for each DS Division. It shows that out of 694 total GN Divisions 579 have permanent officers and other 115 function as acting domains. However, number of vacant GN Divisions differs across DS Divisions. At the time of data collection Nuwaragam Palatha Central, Rambewa and Thalawa show comparatively large number of acting GNs.

As given in the Table 1.4, there are 31,273 pensioners reported from Anuradhapura District. The highest number of pensioners reported from Nuwaragam Palatha East (4,971). Palugaswewa reports the lowest number of pensioners which is 1.4 percent (425) of Anuradhapura total.

At time of the data collection there are 35,820 'Ranaviru' families and 2,202 disabled 'Ranaviru' persons in Anuradhapura District (Table 1.5). Medawachchiya reports the highest number of 'Ranaviru' families. Palugaswewa reports the lowest number of 'Ranaviru' families and also the lowest number disabled 'Ranaviru' persons. Furthermore, there are 7 DS Divisions in Anuradhapura District which exceeds 2,000 of 'Ranaviru' families and 10 DS Divisions which exceeds 100 disabled 'Ranaviru' persons.

2. Availability of Basic facilities

This section presents the information on the availability of basic facilities within the GN Division and on the distance to the nearest location where the basic facilities are available. Data collects on six facilities as follows:

1. Transport

Public transport (bus) start/end destination, railway station, three -wheel park, boat/ferry jetty, road which transport buses/vans/lorries across or near the GN Division

2. Health

Government or private hospital, government or private dispensary, maternity clinic/baby clinic, MOH's office

3. Education

Government or private school which offers classes for A/L, government or private school offering classes for O/L, kindergarten/pre-school/early childhood development centre

4. Communication

Government post office/sub post office or agency post office, Vidhatha Centre/Nena Sala Centre, communication centre

5. Facilities provided by Local government

Public playground, Children park, Praja Shalawa, Public Library/Reading Room, Cemetery, Marketplace/Fair/Public Store

6. Other facilities

Branch of government or private bank, Filling station, Police station, DS office, Local government office

2.1 Transport

Availability of Transport Facilities within Grama Niladhari (GN) Division




Figure 2.1 Number of Grama Niladhari (GN) Divisions where education facilities are available within Grama Niladhari Division by Divisional Secretariat (DS) Division




Figure 2.2 Number of Grama Niladhari Divisions by minimum distance to access post office/Sub Post Office or Agency Post Office and by DS Division

Ten types of government benefits were considered at the survey and collected the counts at GN Division level. The above Table 8.1 gives the aggregated number of beneficiaries at DS Division level. Among the beneficiary majority are "Samurdhi" receivers and "Tuberculosis aid "receives are the lowest. Nachchaduwa DS Division has the lowest "Samurdhi" recipients while Galenbindunuwewa DS Division has the highest in that category. In Medawachchiya DS Division "Kidney aids" recipients are comparatively higher.
