

# CENSUS OF GOVERNMENT AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES, 1951

## INTRODUCTION

*Coverage*—A census of Government employees including teachers in Government schools and Local Government employees was taken by the department on January 31, 1951. The Local Government employees comprised employees in Municipal, Urban and Town Councils, Provincial, District Road Committees and Village Committees. All regularly employed "public servants" who were in employment on the date of the census were included. Daily-paid labourers who were employed on a "casual" basis on the agricultural, industrial and other development schemes of the Government's Six Year Plan were, however, excluded from this census. About 15,000 such labourers were employed in the Irrigation Department. Part-time employees have also been excluded.

*Particulars Collected*—The following particulars were collected in respect of each employee:—  
(a) Employment status, whether permanent or temporary, pensionable or provident fund, daily paid or monthly paid, (b) date of joining service and number of years of service, (c) present salary (exclusive of all allowances) and salary scale, (d) educational attainments and professional examinations passed, (e) sex, (f) age, (g) civil condition, (h) number of children according to specified age groups, (i) distance of residence from place of work, and (j) occupation, if any, of wife or husband. In the case of Local Government employees, the following additional questions were asked:—(a) whether post was scheduled or unscheduled, (b) date of increment, (c) merged salary scale. Copies of the questionnaires used are given in the Appendix.

*Collection of Schedules*—Heads of departments were responsible for getting the schedules of employees in their departments filled up. In the local bodies the Mayors and Chairmen were entrusted with this task, and in Government schools the Principals or Head Teachers were responsible for the schedules of their assistants. The completed schedules were serially numbered by the officers responsible and returned direct to this department.

*The Tables*—The tables in this report are arranged in 4 parts. Tables in Part I deal with the Central Government employees excluding school employees, Part II with the teachers and other employees in Government schools, Part III with Local Government employees, and Part IV with all Central Government employees.

## PART I

### The Central Government Employees (excluding School Employees)

*Table 1*—gives the number of employees by sex in all Government departments which are arranged according to their respective Ministries. Employees who were seconded for service in non-Government institutions are shown separately. The total number of employees was 123,194, of which male employees numbered 114,752 and female employees 8,442. The latter formed 6·9 per cent. of the total number of employees. The Ministry of Health employed the largest number of female workers.

*Table 2*—classifies the employees according to employment status, whether permanent or temporary, pensionable or provident fund. 78,827 employees or about 64 per cent. of the total number of employees were employed on a permanent basis although only 65,470 employees or 53 per cent. of the total number of employees enjoyed pensionable status. Provident fund benefits to permanent employees are a recent innovation of the Treasury. Temporary employees who were neither pensionable nor in receipt of Provident Fund benefits were the daily-paid.

*Table 3*—classifies the employees according to salary scales. More than 50 per cent. of the returns were found to be defective in respect of this information. However, by reference to the description of the posts given in the returns, the salary scales recommended by the 1946 Salaries Commission were assigned. On this basis the missing information was supplied. Salary scales of Army and Navy personnel and other daily-paid employees have been excluded. Sterling salaries were converted and their equivalent scales in rupees are given.

Although there were about 256 different salary scales among the Central Government employees yet only 23 of these salary scales were applicable to the majority (76 per cent.) of the employees. The remaining 233 scales were distributed among the other 24 per cent. of the employees. On an analysis of these remaining scales it is observed that there were as many as 144 scales none of which applied to more than 50 employees.

*Table 4*—shows the frequency distribution of employees according to their salary at date of census exclusive of all allowances. The median salary (exclusive of all allowances) was reckoned to be Rs. 52·59 cts.

*Table 5*—classifies the employees according to grade of worker and length of service. The Public Service is comparatively young—about 72 per cent. of its employees had completed less than 10 years of service.

*Table 6*—classifies the employees according to sex, age group and conjugal condition. 353 in every 1,000 employees were unmarried and the remaining 647 were either married, widowed or divorced. The largest number of employees (49,088) was in the age-group 25–34. The median age of the public servant was 32.

*Table 7*—classifies the employees according to their educational attainments. 537 in every 1,000 employees were returned as having passed some school standard in English. The corresponding proportions for Sinhalese was 661 and Tamil 177. The remaining had either no knowledge of English, Sinhalese or Tamil, or did not specify their knowledge in these languages.

*Table 8*—classifies the employees according to the professional examinations passed. Where more than one professional examination was passed by an employee, only the highest professional examination passed was taken into account.

*Table 9*—classifies the married employees according to the number of children they had. Care was taken to ensure that the children of those couples who are both employed under Government are not counted twice. The number of married employees who did not have children was 12,456. On the average, each married employee had 3·1 children.

*Table 10*—classifies the employees according to the distances of their residences from places of work.

## PART II

### The Government School Employees

The tables in Part II classify the Government school employees (teachers, clerks and others) according to employment status, sex, age group and conjugal condition, length of service, educational attainments, number of children to married employees and distance of residence from place of work. They are further classified according to salary scale and present salary.

## PART III

### The Local Government Employees

The tables in Part III classify the Local Government employees according to employment status, sex, age group and conjugal condition, length of service, educational attainments, number of children to married employees, distance of residence from place of work, and also according to their present salary. At the time of the census a unified salary scale was being introduced by the Local Government Service Commission and therefore particulars *re* salary scales were not available in the majority of cases.

## PART IV

### All Central Government Employees

The following two tables relate to all Central Government employees.

*Table 1*—classifies the occupations of the spouses (of employees) who were gainfully occupied. There were 11,826 persons in Government Service whose wives or husbands had some gainful employment. Of this number 5,334 men employees had their wives employed and 6,492 women employees had their husbands employed. There were at least 2,818 couples employed in Government Service—an accurate figure was not available as some employees had not given the source of employment of their spouses. About 13 per cent. of the total number of married employees had their incomes supplemented by the earnings of their partners. The corresponding percentages for the male employees was 6·5 and female employees 65·1.

*Table 2*—classifies the employees according to salary scales and present (monthly) salary groups.
