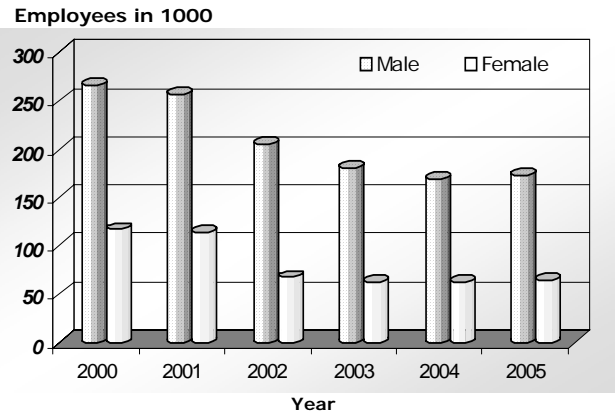
Introduction

- Data Collection of Employment Statistics in Semi – Government Sector is being conducted by the Department of Census & Statistics annually since 1966, as at 31st December.
- The Semi – Government Sector comprises of the Corporations, Boards, Authorities, Institutions of Government Owned Business undertaking.
- Data is collected by mailing questionnaires to the Semi – Government Sector institutions.
- This questionnaire is specially designed to collect information about Estate Labourers and this is the only source. It provides information about Number of Employees, their Sex, Status of Appointment and Occupation categories.
- In year 2005 the frame consists 329 institutions.
- This frame is being updated by using the frame of Census of Public and Semi – Government Sector Employment once in four years.

Figure 1: Distribution Semi – Government Sector Employees by Sex 2000 - 2005

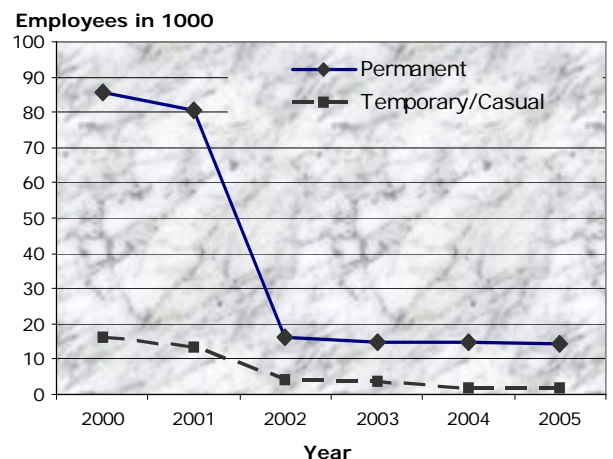


- ❖ The male employees participation is higher than the female employees participation in Semi – Government Sector since this sector consists of mostly industrial oriented occupations.
- ❖ There was an increase of 2.1% of employees in the year 2005 in compared to the previous year (Male participation increased by 1.8 % and Female participation increased by 3.1%).

Figure 2: Distribution of Estate Labourers by Status of Appointment 2000 – 2005



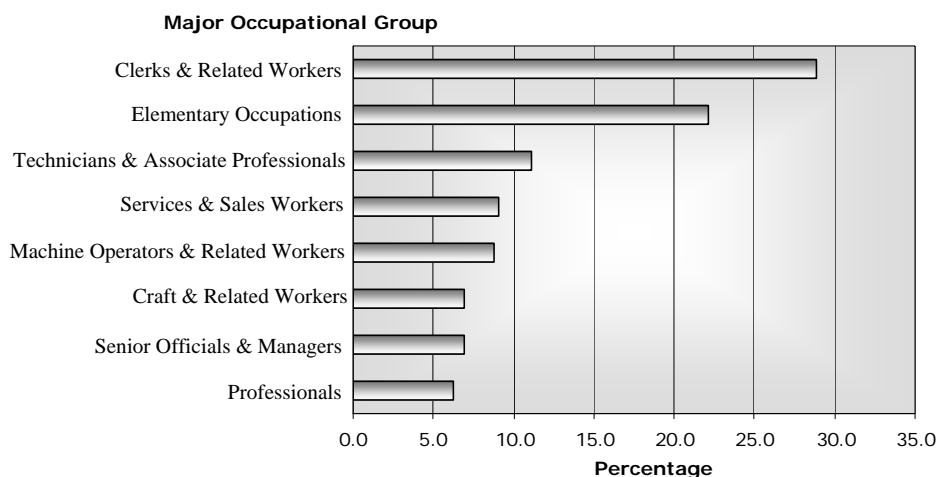
- Number of female employees in state owned estates is much higher than male employees.

- ❖ Number of Permanent male employees are nearly three times of the female employees.
- ❖ More than 27% of female employees engaged in Senior Officials and Managers group, Professionals group and Technicians & Associate Professionals group but female participation is higher in Clerks & Related Workers group.

- ❖ The highest percentage of employees has been reported in the Clerks and Related Workers group(28.9%).
- ❖ The Elementary Occupations Group was the second highest(22%) among the Major Occupational groups.
- ❖ Nearly 38% of the employees belong to the Skilled Workers and Unskilled Workers groups.
