

INTRODUCTION

Census of Public and Semi – Government Sector Employment conducted by the Department of Census and Statistics on 1st July 2006 is the 7th in the series. The previous censuses were done in 1980, 1985, 1990, 1994, 1998 and 2002. Since 1990, the department conducts this census once in four years

Information of the employees of Permanent, Casual, Temporary, Contract Basis or other basis under the following sectors are collected.

State Sector :

All the ministries, departments and Institutions not coming under any ministry but under the central government are included.

Provincial Public Sector :

All the ministries and institutions coming under the provincial councils.

Semi-Government Sector :

Corporations, Boards, Authorities, State Banks and Public Private Companies

The Census was conducted among 62 ministries and eight Provincial Councils. There were 1055 institutions under state sector, 708 institutions under Provincial Public Sector and 265 institutions under Semi-Government Sector.

To fulfill the immediate requirements of data users, Department of Census and Statistics decided to publish a preliminary report. Data given here are based on the summary prepared by the co-ordinating officers of the respective institution. The summary contains 7 variables selected from the census questionnaire. The variables are ..
