Producer's Price Index (PPI)

The Producer's Price Index (PPI) measures the average change over the time in prices received by domestic producers of goods and services. The introduction of the PPI in Sri Lanka provides a more complete picture of price movements and trends for making informed policy decisions. Department of Census and Statistics (DCS) has been releasing PPI quarterly from September, 2015 with time lag of 35 days. Giving due consideration for making the estimates available more frequently, it has now been arranged to release PPI monthly with a time lag of 45 days.

PPI is an important macro-economic indicator. It serves as an indicator of short-term inflationary trends and as a deflator of economic series. It is also used in productivity analysis, contract escalation, business analysis and current cost accounting etc. PPI covers the Agriculture, Manufacturing and Electricity & Water supply sectors of the economy.

- In the PPI for all economic activities: agriculture, manufacturing and water supply & electricity, for the month of August 2021 is 158.0.
- I The annual change in the PPI has been compiled as 9.4 per cent.
- Comparing the month on month changes, PPI in August 2021 has increased to 158.0 from 157.5 reported in July 2021.

Annual Changes of Producer's Price Index (PPI)

The PPI for all economic activities: agriculture, manufacturing and water supply & electricity, for the month of August 2021 is 158.0. The annual change in the PPI has been compiled as 9.4 per cent. The PPI is reported for the three major economic activities, agriculture, manufacturing and electricity & water supply are 172.0, 152.3 and 89.9 respectively. The manufacturing and electricity & water supply activities are reported positive changes of 10.5 per cent and 1.8 per cent. While that of agriculture activity is reported negative change of 0.8 per cent on annual basis (Table 1).

Both sub activities of agriculture sector "Farming of animals" and "Growing crops" **Are** reported negative changes of 2.5 per cent and 0.7 per cent respectively on annual basis. The sub activities related to "Farming of animals": "Production of dairy" is recorded positive change of 13.9 per cent and "Production of eggs" is reported negative change of 10.5 per cent on annual basis. Sub activities related to "Growing of crops": "Growing of vegetables" is recorded positive annual change of 22.4 per cent. While that of "Growing of fruits, nuts and beverage and spice crops" and "Growing of cereals and other crops" are recorded negative annual changes of 3.1 per cent and 0.5 per cent in the month of August 2021 compared to the same month in 2020.

The sub activities of manufacturing sector, "Manufacturing of coke, refined petroleum products and nuclear fuel" (48.1%), "Manufacturing of basic metals'' (21.0%), "Manufacturing of furniture and Manufacturing of goods not elsewhere classified" (19.9%), "Manufacturing of chemicals and chemical products" (14.0%), "Manufacturing of other transport equipment"(13.5%), "Manufacturing of Textiles" (13.0%), "Manufacturing of rubber and plastics"(12.7%), "Manufacturing of wearing apparel, dressing, and dyeing of fur"(11.1%), "Publishing, printing and reproduction of recorded media" (9.8%), "Manufacturing of electrical machinery and apparatus not elsewhere classified" (8.3%), "Manufacturing of food products and beverages" (5.7%), "Manufacturing of other non-metallic mineral products" (5.5%) and "Manufacturing of tobacco products" (0.5%) are reported positive percentage changes respectively on annual basis when compared to the August 2020 (Table 4).

The activities in utility sector, "Generation and distribution of electricity" and "Collection purification and distribution of water" are reported positive changes of 1.9 per cent and 1.4 per cent in the month of August 2021 compared to the same month in 2020 (Table 4).

Monthly Changes of Producer's Price Index

Comparing the month-on-month changes, PPI in August 2021 has increased to 158.0 from 157.5 was reported in July 2021. This shows an increase of 0.5 index points or 0.3 percentages compared to the July 2021. The three major economic activities, electricity and water supply, manufacturing and agriculture are reported positive changes of 2.0 per cent, 0.3 per cent and 0.1 per cent respectively as compared to the previous month (Table 2).

The sub activities of agriculture sector, "Farming of animals" (3.7%) is reported positive percentage change and "Growing of crops" (0.1%) is reported negative percentage change on monthly basis. Sub activities related to, "Farming of animals": "Egg production" (4.4%) and "Production of dairy" (2.6%) are reported positive percentage changes respectively on monthly basis. "Growing of crops": "Growing of vegetables" (2.7%) is reported positive percentage change on monthly basis. While that of "Growing of fruits, nuts and beverage and spice crops" (0.4%) and "Growing of cereals and other crops" (0.3%) are reported negative percentage changes on monthly basis.

In the manufacturing sector, the sub activities, "Manufacturing of coke, refined petroleum products and nuclear fuel" (2.7%), "Manufacturing of rubber and plastics" (1.2%), "Manufacturing of food products and beverages" (1.0%), "Manufacturing of Textiles" (0.8%), "Manufacturing of chemicals and chemical products" (0.5%), "Manufacturing of basic metals" (0.5%), "Manufacturing of furniture and Manufacturing of goods not elsewhere classified" (0.3%),"Publishing, printing and reproduction of recorded media" (0.1%) and "Manufacturing of other non-metallic mineral products" (0.1%) are reported positive percentage changes. While that of "Manufacturing of wearing apparel, dressing, and dyeing of fur" (0.8%) is reported negative percentage change on monthly basis. Meanwhile "Manufacturing of tobacco products", "Manufacturing of electrical machinery and apparatus not elsewhere classified" and "Manufacturing of other transport equipment" sub activities remained unchanged during the month of August 2021 on monthly basis (Table 4).


Both sub activities of the utility sector, "Generation and distribution of electricity" and "Collection, purification and distribution of water" are reported same positive change of 2.1 per cent in the month of August 2021 on monthly basis (Table 4).

Revision Policy

PPI is compiled by collecting prices received by the domestic producers for about 514 products from 376 manufacturing and utility related establishments. Prices of 36 agricultural products are collected from 331 Divisional Secretariat Divisions covering the entire country. Electricity & Water supply sector prices are collected from Ceylon Electricity Board and National Water Supply & Drainage Board respectively.

In certain circumstances, it is not possible to collect requested prices by the time of releasing PPI. Such prices are therefore, statistically imputed. Therefore, indices of the latest month are released as provisional.

Producer's Price Index (PPI) is released monthly with 45 days time lag with effect from January, 2017. The PPI for month of September, 2021 will be released on 15th of November 2021.
