THE NATIONAL CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (BASE 2013=100): FEBRUARY 2020

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
Issuing the National Consumer Price Index (NCPI), for the month of February 2020, the Director General of Census and Statistics said that headline inflation as measured by the Year-on-Year change (The percentage change in the current month NCPI over same month NCPI of last year) based on the NCPI has been compiled as 8.1%. The headline inflation reported for the month of January 2020 was 7.6%. Contributions to the inflation rate of February 2020 from food group and non-food group are 7.0% and 1.2% respectively. Whilst contributions of food and non-food groups to the inflation in February 2019 were -1.3% and 3.7% respectively, resulting in a headline inflation of 2.4%. With respect to February 2019, the reported increase in percentage of food group was mainly due to higher price levels prevailed in this month of February 2020, particularly prices of vegetables, rice, coconuts, red onions, fresh fish, big onions and milk powder.

The NCPI for all items for the month of February 2020 was 137.0. It indicates no change in index points or percentage as compared to January 2020 for which the index was 137.0. The month-on-month change was contributed by decrease of index values of food items by 0.05% and increase of index values of non-food items by 0.05%.

Price decreases of food items were reported for vegetables, rice, green chilies, red onions, potatoes, limes, fresh fish and chicken. However, price increases of food items were reported for coconuts, big onions, coconut oil, papaw, garlic, chili powder, mysore dhal, mangoes, sugar and yoghurt.

The increases in index values of non-food groups in February 2020 compared to the previous month was due to the price increases in groups of items 'Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics' (*Betel leaves*), 'Clothing and Footwear' and 'Transport' (*Airline fare*). Further, very slight price increases were reported in groups of 'Furnishing, Household equipment Routine household maintenance', 'Miscellaneous Goods and Services' and 'Recreation and Culture' compared to the preceding month. Meanwhile, the price indices of 'Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other fuels', 'Health', 'Communication', 'Education' and 'Restaurants and Hotels' groups remained unchanged during the month.

Core inflation, which reflects the underlying inflation by excluding volatile items of food, energy and transport groups in the economy as measured by the Year-on-Year change based on NCPI for the month of February 2020 has declined to 3.4% from 3.9% in January 2020.
