The National Consumer Price Index (NCPI) with an index reference period 2013=100 was updated to a new index reference period of 2021= 100 from January 2023. Issuing the NCPI, for the month of November 2023, the Director General of Census and Statistics said that headline inflation as measured by the Year-on-Year change (The percentage change in the current month NCPI over same month NCPI of last year) based on the NCPI has been compiled as 2.8%. The headline inflation reported for the month of October 2023 was 1.0%. Contributions to the inflation rate of November 2023 from the food group and non-food group are -1.0% and 3.9% respectively. On a monthly basis, the Year-on-Year inflation of the food group increased to -2.2% in November 2023 from -5.2% in October 2023 and the Year-on-Year inflation of the non-food group increased to 7.1% in November 2023 from 6.3% in October 2023.

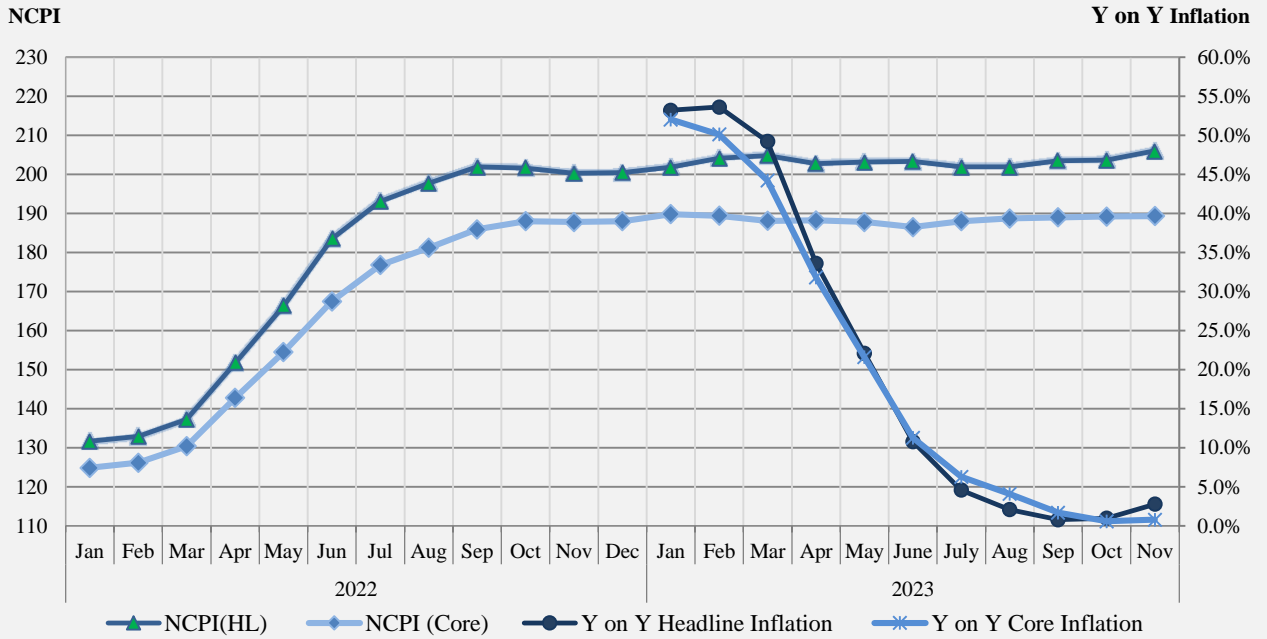
Comparing the month-on-month changes, NCPI (Base 2021=100) in November 2023 has increased to 206.0 from 203.6 reported in October 2023. This shows an increase of 2.4 index points or 1.19 percent as compared to October 2023. The month-on-month change was contributed by increases in food items and non-food items of 0.77% and 0.43% respectively.

Price increases of food items were mainly reported for Vegetables, Rice, Sugar, Coconuts, Big onions, Green chilies, Red onions, Limes, Coconut oil, Potatoes, Mysore dhal, Tea dust/leaves and Fresh fruits. However, decreases in prices were reported for Fresh fish, Chicken, Dried fish, Eggs, Green gram and Chili powder.

The increases in index values of non-food groups in November 2023 compared to the previous month was mainly due to the price increases in groups of items 'Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other fuels' (*Materials for the Maintenance and Electricity bill*) and 'Restaurants and Hotels'. However, price decreases in groups of items were reported for 'Transport' (*Petrol*), 'Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics' (*Beetle leaves*) and 'Health' (*Spectacles*). Further, very slight price decreases were reported in groups of 'Clothing and Footwear', 'Furnishing, Household equipment and Routine household maintenance', 'Recreation and Culture' and 'Miscellaneous Goods and Services'. Meanwhile, the price indices of 'Communication' and 'Education' groups remained unchanged during the month.

Core inflation, which reflects the underlying inflation by excluding volatile items of food, energy and transport groups in the economy as measured by the Year-on-Year change based on NCPI (Base 2021=100) for the month of November 2023 was increased to 0.8% from 0.6% reported in month of October 2023.
