

## **Demographic & Health Survey (2006/07) : Selected Tables from the Chapters of the Final Report**

Demographic & Health Survey (2006/07) conducted by the Department of Census & Statistics provides important information on Fertility, Family Planning, Maternal and Child Health, Nutrition and awareness of HIV/AIDS. The survey is designed to provide National as well as district and sector wise estimates. The survey covered all parts of the country excluding Northern Province. Information was collected from 19,872 households. Main target group of the survey was ever married women in the 15-49 age group and their children below 5 years of age at the time of the survey.
