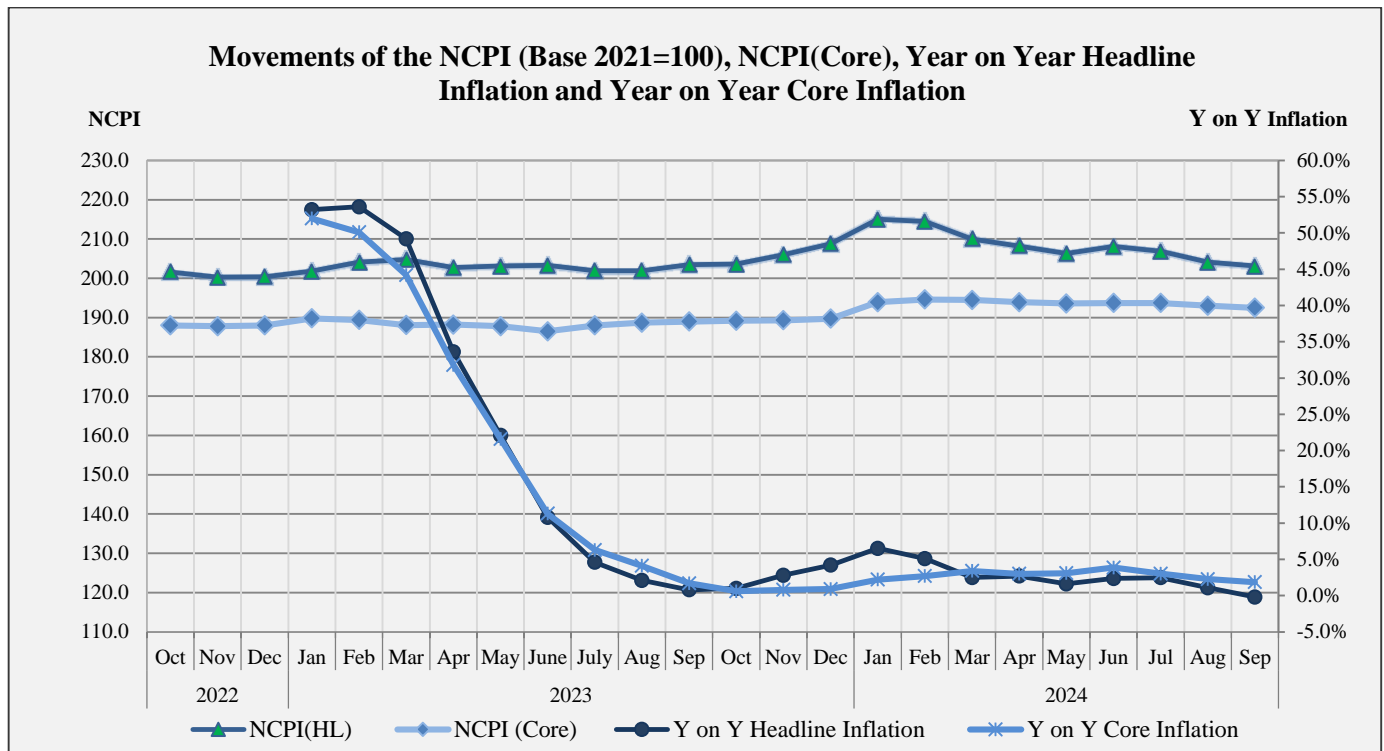
Issuing the NCPI, for the month of September 2024, the Director General of Census and Statistics said that headline inflation as measured by the Year-on-Year change (The percentage change in the current month NCPI over same month NCPI of last year) based on the NCPI has been compiled as -0.2%. The headline inflation reported for the month of August 2024 was 1.1%. Contributions to the inflation rate of September 2024 from the food group and non-food group are 0.2% and -0.4% respectively. On a monthly basis, the Year-on-Year inflation of the food group decreased to 0.5% in September 2024 from 2.3% in August 2024 and the Year-on-Year inflation of the non-food group decreased to -0.7% in September 2024 from 0.2% in August 2024.

Comparing the month-on-month changes, NCPI (Base 2021=100) in September 2024 has decreased to 203.1 from 204.1 reported in August 2024. This shows a decrease of 1.0 index points or 0.48 percent as compared to August 2024. The month-on-month change was contributed by a decrease in food items of 0.35% and in non-food items of 0.13%, respectively.

Price decreases of food items were mainly reported for Vegetables, Limes, Potatoes, Chicken, Eggs, Ginger, Green chilies, Sugar, Mysore dhal, Chili powder, Green Gram, Dried chilies, Infant milk powder and wheat flour. However, increases in index values were reported for Fresh fruits, Coconuts, Rice, Big onions, Turmeric powder and Tea dust /leaves.

The decreases in index values of non-food groups in September 2024 compared to the previous month was mainly due to the price decreases in groups of items 'Transport' (*Petrol*), 'Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other fuels' (*Water bill*) and 'Furnishing, Household equipment and Routine household maintenance'. However, price increases in groups of items were reported for 'Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics' and 'Education (*School fees (International)*)'. Further, very slight price increases were reported in groups of 'Clothing and Footwear' and 'Recreation and Culture'. However, very slight price decreases were reported in groups of 'Restaurants and Hotels' and 'Miscellaneous Goods and Services'. Meanwhile, the price indices of 'Health' and 'Communication' groups remained unchanged during the month.

Core inflation, which reflects the underlying inflation by excluding volatile items of food, energy and transport groups in the economy as measured by the Year-on-Year change based on NCPI (Base 2021=100) for the month of September 2024 was decreased to 1.9% from 2.3% reported in month of August 2024.
